<p><u>What is a blog ?</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ A blog is a website of your own where you enter information ordered by date. ▪ It can also be called an online diary or online journal that is shared with others online. 	<p><u>Webpages</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Webpages are documents commonly written in HTML that is accessible through the internet or other networks using an internet browse. ▪ Webpages are accessed by entering a URL address and may contain text, graphic and hyperlinks to other webpages and files.
<p><u>Why might blog posts be censored?</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Sometimes people can publish things online that are illegal or offensive. ▪ In these instances, the published document can be removed, banned or content can be restricted. ▪ It is important to consider what you publish very carefully. 	<p><u>Google's advanced searches</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Advanced search is a built-in feature of Google which allows a user to specify additional requirements for a search. ▪ When used for searching the Web, an advanced search gives additional information to Google, which helps re- fine the search.
<p><u>What are group emails?</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Email is a great way to send a message. ▪ This can be very useful if you want to share a message or document with a group of people all at once. ▪ When you send an email, the recipient can either reply to just the sender or reply to all other recipients too. ▪ If you 'reply to all', all the other people included in the email will also be able to read your reply. 	<p><u>URL</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Uniform Resource Locator, termed a web address, refers to a web source that specifies its location on a computer network.
<p><u>'cc' and 'bcc'</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ When sending emails you can also 'cc' in recipients and 'bcc' recipients. ▪ CC stands for 'carbon copy'. ▪ It is useful when you want someone else to receive a copy of an email, but they aren't one of the primary recipients. You want the recipients of the message to know the other people who have been sent the message. ▪ BCC stands for 'blind carbon copy'. ▪ BCC is a useful way to let others see and email you have sent without the main recipient knowing. 	
<p><u>Censored</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ something is examined and parts of purposefully left out or removed. <p><u>Podcast</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ a digital audio file made available on the internet for downloading. <p><u>Global audience</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ these are the people that can view things on the internet across the world. 	<p><u>Distribution</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ sharing something out among a number of recipients. <p><u>Benefits</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ an advantage or profit gained from something. <p><u>Risks</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ a situation involving possible danger or problems
